## Eligibility for Entitlement

- ❖ If you are in receipt of any of the following your child will be entitled for Free School Meals if your child is in years 3 to 4, or Pupil Premium funding if your child is in years Reception to year 2:
- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400 as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
  - Income Support
  - Income-based Jobseekers Allowance
  - Income-related Employment Support Allowance
  - Support under part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 (from the National Asylum Support Service)
  - The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
  - Child Tax Credit (provided you're **not also entitled to Working Tax Credit**) and have an annual income no more than £16,190

*Note: If you are in receipt of Working Tax Credit during the four week period immediately after your employment ceases, or after you start to work less than 16 hours per week, your child/children are entitled to free meals*

Your application may be checked using The Department for Education Free School Meals Eligibility Checking Service using the information you have provided on this form. The results will be a yes/no confirmation and your child's school will be informed of this.

You may be requested by the school to provide documentary proof of entitlement.

### Data Security

**Personal data provided on this form may be held on a computer and is therefore subject to the Data Protection Act 1998. It will only be used for the intended purpose i.e. to determine eligibility for Free School Meals or Pupil Premium.**
