We will be learning:

To take account of other's views – listen to each other during group time and share news/ideas

To welcomes & value praise. To express interests and opinions. Is secure, confident and shows high levels of well being

We will be learning:

Talk about their experiences and act out roles in the outside learning area eg. A trip to the seaside. Beach, sea, dinghies, information centre
