By the end of their time at Whitley Park we aspire for the children to be competent with using the three core skills in the Geography curriculum:

- Collect, Analyse and Communicate with data gathered through fieldwork that deepens their geographical understanding
- Interpret a range of sources of geographical information including maps, diagrams, globes, aerial photographs, GIS systems
- Communicate information in a variety of ways including maps and writing at length
