

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

This term in Personal, Social and Emotional Development sessions, the children will be learning to:

- Identify feelings and emotions
- Learn how to negotiate with others to solve their problems independently
- Work as a group and take notice of other children's views on how to complete their game.



Literacy

This term in Literacy we will be learning the story of 'The Bad-Tempered Ladybird,' by Eric Carle. We will also:

- Practise writing longer phrases and sentences, using our Phonic knowledge to support our writing
- Practise reading and writing common words, e.g. the, they, her, he, she
- Use capital letters, finger spaces (between words) and full stops accurately.

Communication and Language

This term the children will be learning to:

- Use whole sentences
- Use tenses accurately when talking about things they have done, or will do in the future.
- Listen attentively in a range of situations (including assembly)
- Answer how and why questions about stories and events.

Physical Development

This term in Physical Development the children will be learning to:

- Move to music, thinking carefully about rhythm, speed and direction
- Hold a pencil correctly, using a 'Beaky Bird' grip (hold pencil between thumb and forefinger)
- Practise handwriting in our handwriting books



Mathematics

This term in Mathematics the children will be learning to:

- Double and halve numbers
- Count in 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Identify 3D shapes in the environment
- Use everyday language to talk about money and time
- Use Mathematical language to describe objects.

Expressive Arts and Design

This term in Expressive Arts and Design the children will be learning to:

- Use everyday objects to create props for role play
- Explore design, form, function and texture
- Play in a group to act out a narrative.

Understanding the World

This term in Understanding the World we will be learning to:

- Identify and name insects
- Name the body parts of insects
- Talk about similarities and differences between families, traditions and cultures.

Phonics

The children will continue to recap the Speed Sounds and learn to use these confidently in their reading and writing. We will progress from reading simple cvc words (e.g. cat), to more challenging words (e.g. plank, stamp). We will also learn to read phrases and sentences and understand the information we are reading.
