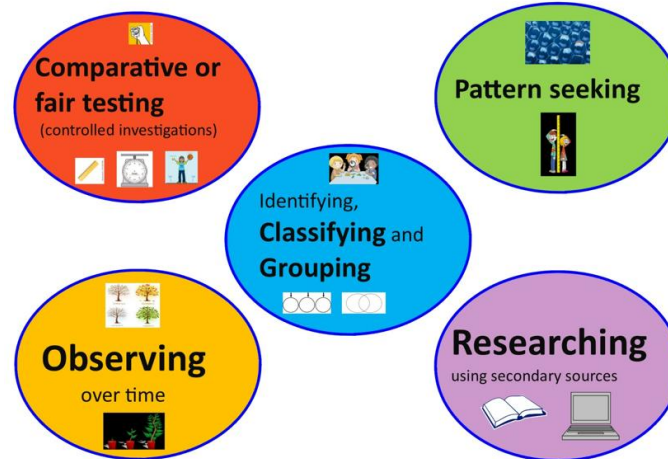


Year 3 Autumn 1 Curriculum Map

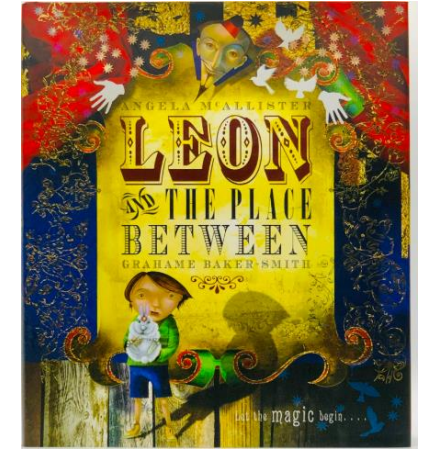

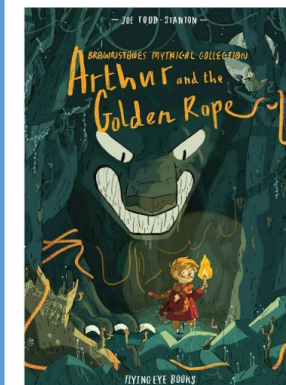
