Maths- Fractions the four operations and money

- I can identify ½, 1/4, 1/3, 2/4 and ¾ of a number, shape and amount.
- I know the multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables.
- I know how to add and subtract twodigit numbers using concrete objects, pictorial representations and mental methods.
- I know how to count and compare amounts of money.
- I know how to use pounds and pennies and use this to find change.

Geography

- I know the names of the 7 continents and 5 oceans.
- I know where hot and cold areas of the world are.
- I know how to compare and contrast the geographical similarities and differences between Africa and Europe (physical and human).

Computing

- I can explore different types of information technology
- I know how information technology is used in school, at home and in the wider world.
- I can log on to a laptop and use a search engine to find an image.

Year 2, Summer 5 - Africa

Does it snow in Africa?

Intent: For children to understand where they live in the wider context of the world and to be able to place themselves within it. For children to understand climate zones and how and why different weather occurs.

<u>Science</u>

- I know that animals including humans have offspring that grows into adults.
- I know and can describe the basic needs of animals, including humans, for survival (water, food and air).
- I can describe the importance for humans of exercise, eating the right amounts of different types of food, and hygiene.

- I know about foods that support good health and the risks of eating too much sugar.

- I know the role money plays in my life including how to manage money, keep it safe, make informed choices about spending money and what influences those choices.

Writing

- I know how to punctuate my sentence correctly with capital letters, full stops, exclamation marks and question marks.
- I know how to use coordinating and subordinating conjunctions in my writing.
- I know how to use apostrophes for possession and for contraction.
- I know how to use different tenses in my writing.
- I know what nouns, adjectives and verbs are.
- I know how to add description to my writing by using expanded noun phrases
- I know how to write using a joined, cursive handwriting style.
- I know how to spell Year 2 common exception words.
- I know the four different sentence types (statement, command, exclamation, question).

<u>PE</u>

- I can strike and hit a ball with increasing control.
- I can throw and catch a ball.
- I can travel with a ball and pass it in a game.
- I can use different ways of travelling in a game.
- I can begin to understand the terms 'attacking' and 'defending'.
