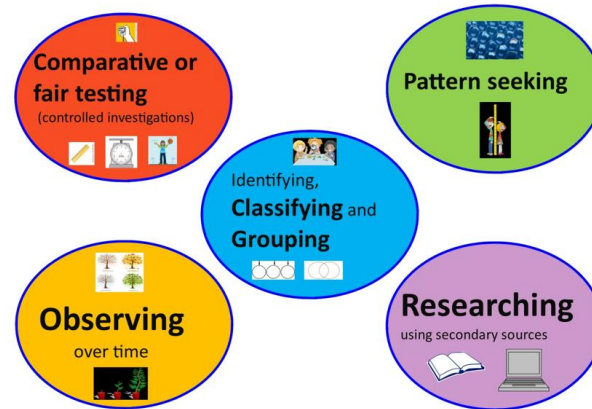

Science

Changes of States

- Compare and group materials together, according to whether they are solids, liquids or gases.
- Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled, and measure or research the temperature at which this happens in degrees Celsius (°C)
- Identify the part played by evaporation and condensation in the water cycle and associate the rate of evaporation with temperature

Artist Focus: Gaudi; create a mosaic; design and create a chimney pot sculpture using clay, inspired by Gaudi

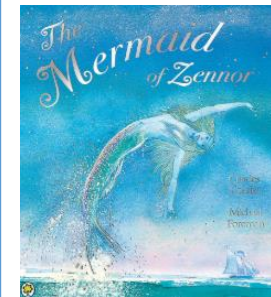
