Geography

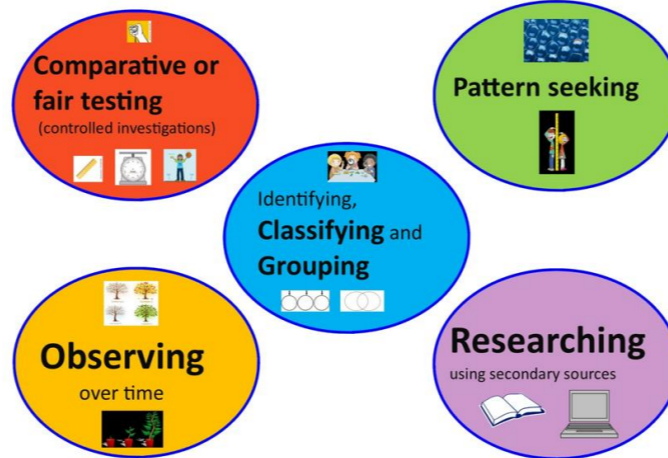
- Use knowledge of the countries and capital cities of the United Kingdom to locate castles on a map.

- Why and where were castles built in the four countries of the United Kingdom?

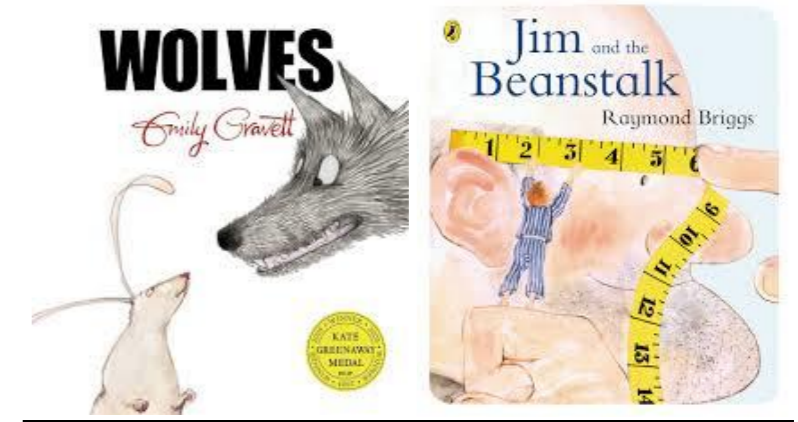
PE
