- We will explore the history of Christmas as part of our festive performance.

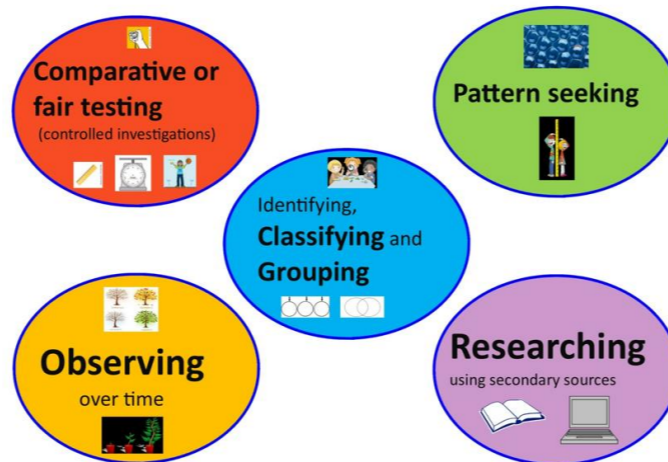
History
