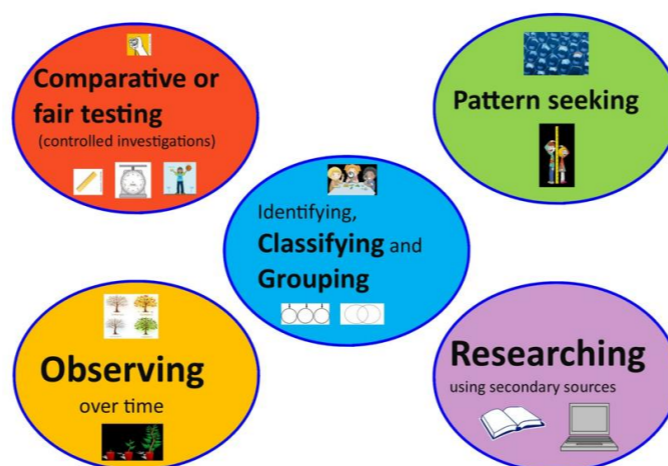

- How do we keep people safe at sea?

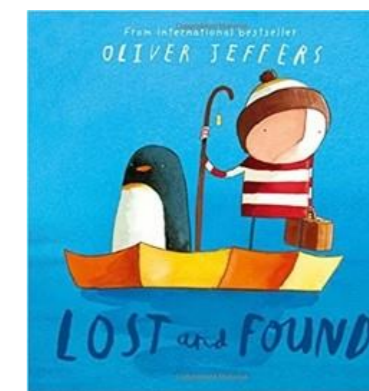
