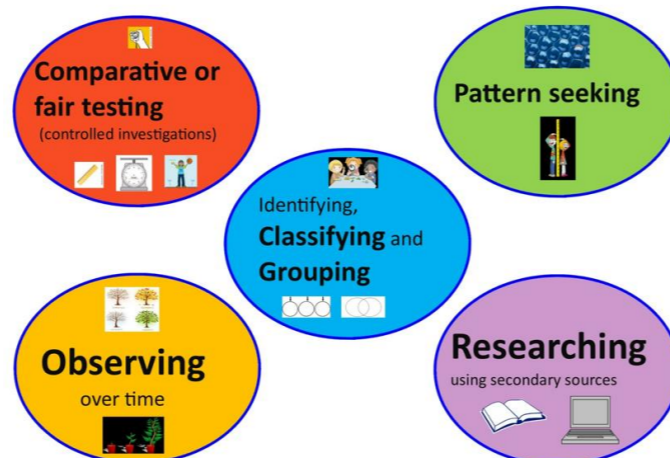

Science

Physics: Light and Shadow

- Recognise that they need light in order to see things and that dark is the absence of light;
- Notice that light is reflected from surfaces;
- Recognise that light from the sun can be dangerous and that there are ways to protect their eyes;
- Recognise that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by an opaque object;
- Find patterns in the way that the size of shadows change.

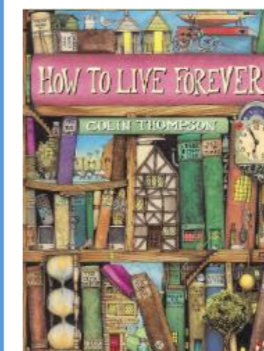

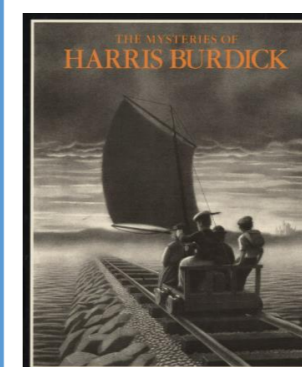
