Maths

Unit coverage:

- Decimals and percentages
- Statistics

Mental Maths skills:

- Fractions of amounts

Times Tables:

- In Year 5, children must be able to fluently recall multiplication and division facts to the 12 times table. Times Table Rockstars and flash card interventions are being used to support this. This term the children will be focusing on clay sculptures. They will be developing their skills, using a range of tools.

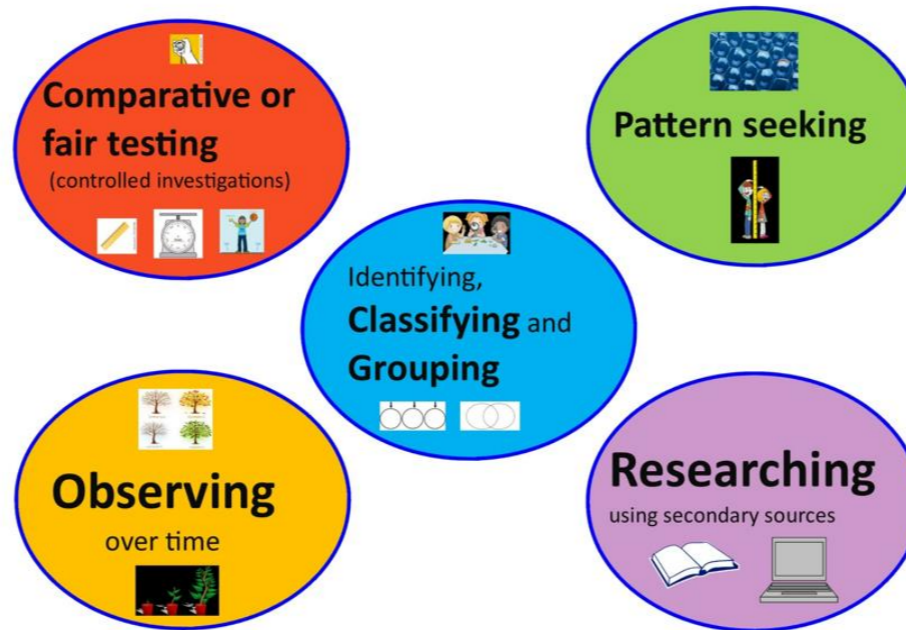
D&T

Science

Properties and Changes of Materials PART 2

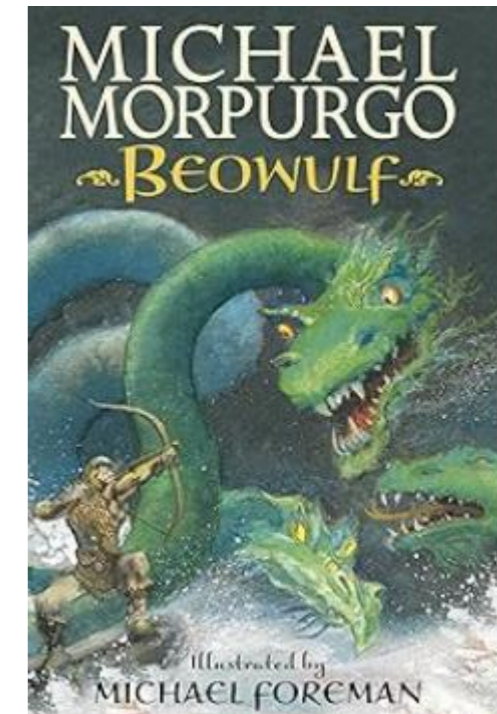
- Know that some materials will dissolve in liquid to form a solution, and describe how to recover a substance from a solution.
- Use knowledge of solids, liquids and gases to decide how mixtures might be separated, including through filtering, sieving and evaporating.
- Demonstrate that dissolving, mixing and changes of state are reversible changes.
- Explain that some changes result in the formation of new materials, and that this kind of change is not usually reversible, including changes associated with burning and the action of acid on bicarbonate of soda.

Over the course of this half term, we will be learning about where the Kingdom of Benin was. We will be exploring artefacts and learning about why it is difficult to be certain about the history of Benin. We will also be learning about the slave trade and why the Kingdom of Benin came to an end.

Writing



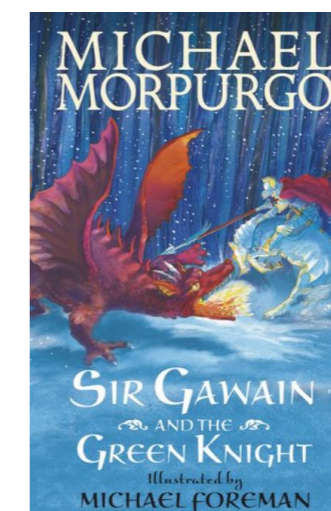
Beowulf by Michael Morpurgo
